Mission 2025 update

Mission 2025 sets out Table Tennis England's aims and ambitions for the sport, from grassroots to elite, for the 10 years beginning in 2015.

It outlines the work we plan to carry out in four key areas – Participation, Places, People and Performance – to improve and grow the sport. People and Places are known as the *enablers*, from which Participation and Performance will result.

The Board monitors progress against an annual operating plan. Below is a summary of progress made against each strategic priority in the two years since the last Mission 2025 update was carried in the Annual Review of 2017.

Our workforce – coaches, officials and volunteers – are at the heart of our sport and our role is to ensure they are trained, supported and recognised, as well as to provide a pathway of qualifications for those who wish to progress their careers within coaching or officiating.

One of our strategic priorities is to increase the number of females in the sport and the women and girls' action plan was launched at the National Conference following a year of planning and consultation via a series of workshops and webinars.

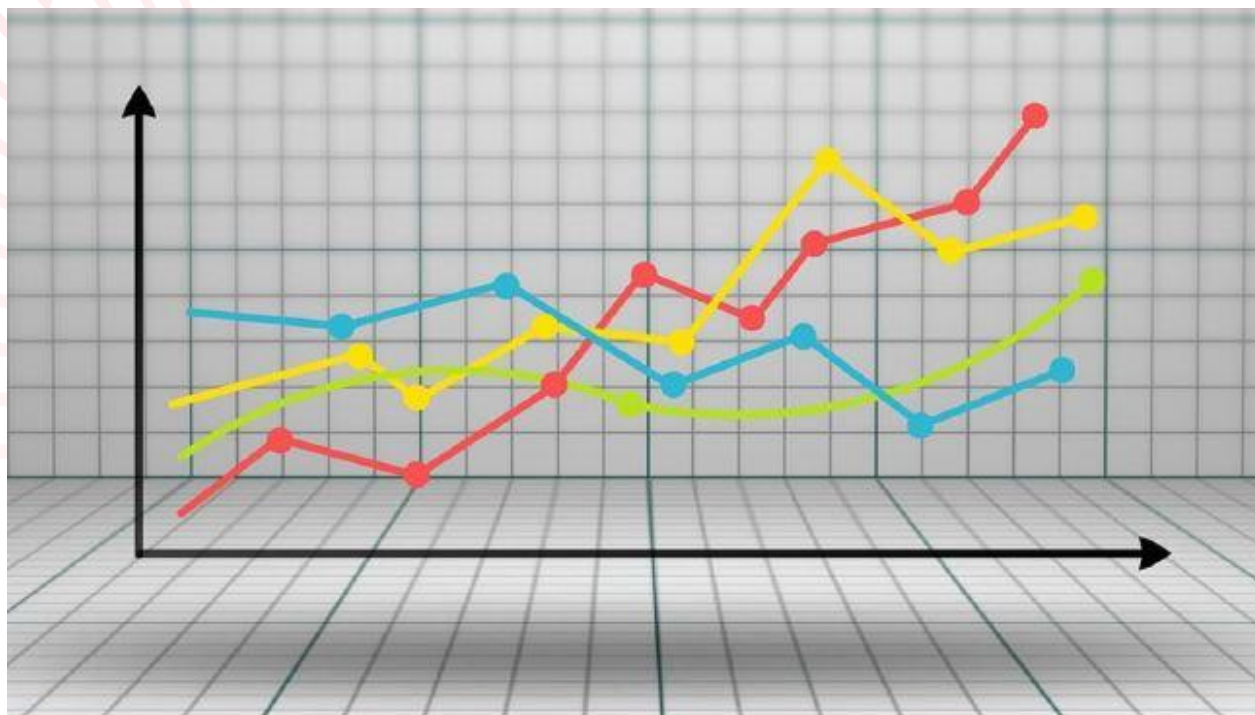

- Concern with negotiations to maintain current platform
- Cost of current system escalating to 5x current cost

- Mid March selected League Administrators met for Technical Specification
- Early April Comms opened up for Leagues to form part of the testing and consultation
- Mid April Comms to League Secretaries on functionality, timelines & FAQs
