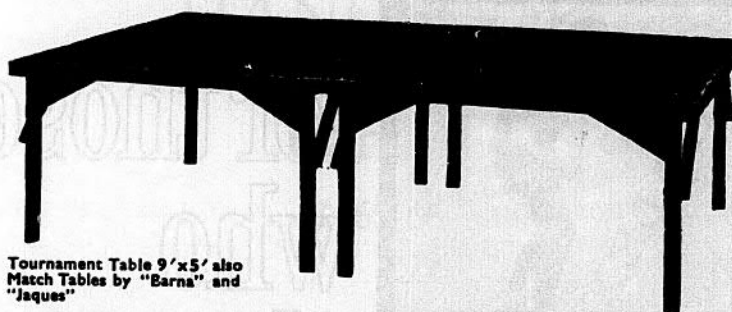

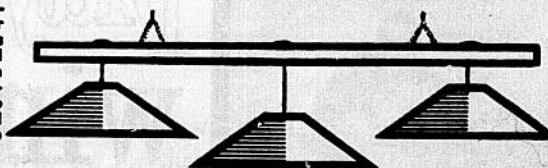

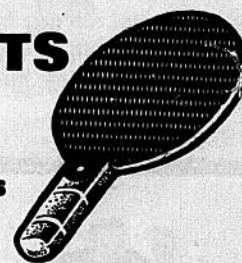

Failure of any Member without good and sufficient cause to attend the Hearing of any allegation or appeal after having been requested with reasonable notice so to do, or failure without good and sufficient cause to answer any question put to him in connection with such allegation or appeal shall be deemed misconduct.
- 42 Upon any breach of these Rules or of the Regulations made thereunder or of any misconduct as defined in these Rules being proved to the satisfaction of the National Council, the Council shall have power to order the Member or organisation guilty of such breach or misconduct (the offender)

- 43 Any individual or club aggrieved by a decision or action of a Local League, or a Committee or Officer of such League, may appeal against such decision or action to the County Association to which such Local League is affiliated, or if there be no such County Association, to the National Council of the E.T.T.A., and the decision of the body to which the appeal is made shall be final and binding on all parties.
- 43A. (a) Any individual, club or Local League aggrieved by a decision or action of a County Association, or a Committee or Officer of such Association, or of the E.T.T.A., or the National Council, or a Committee or Officer of the E.T.T.A., may appeal against any such decision or action to the Board of Appeal of the E.T.T.A., whose decision shall be final and binding on all parties.
- (b) The Board of Appeal shall consist of three persons selected by the Management Committee from a panel of eight persons appointed by the National Council but not being members of the Council.

(c) The procedure for matters being dealt with by the Board of Appeal shall be determined by the Board and a copy of the Regulations governing such procedure shall be supplied to every organisation or Member against whom a breach of Rule or Regulation or misconduct is alleged, or any organisation or Member making any appeal under these Rules.

43B. Any such appeal shall be made in writing to the General Secretary of the appropriate body within 21 days of the decision or action appealed against, and shall be accompanied by a fee of 10/- in the case of an individual or £2 in the case of an organisation which shall be returned if the adjudicating body consider the making of an appeal to have been justified (whatever the result). Either party to the appeal shall be entitled to be heard by the adjudicating body, both in person and, if so desired, additionally by a representative who shall have been nominated in writing when the appeal was lodged.

43C. The Rules of the Association being sufficient to enable the National Council, as the governing body of the game of Table Tennis in England, or the Board of Appeal to deal with all cases of dispute, legal proceedings shall be taken only as a last resort, after the full procedure laid down by these Rules and any Regulations made thereunder shall have been followed through.

The Association shall be entitled to publish in the public Press, or in any other manner it shall think fit, reports of its proceedings, acts and resolutions, whether the same shall or shall not reflect upon the character or conduct of any league, club or Member, and every such league, club and Member shall be deemed to have assented to such publication.

APPENDIX "E"

Regulations governing the procedure for dealing with allegations of breach of Rule or Regulation or of misconduct.

1 In the event of any breach of Rule or Regulation or of any misconduct being alleged against any Member or organisation, notice shall be given to such Member or organisation in accordance with Rule 42A.

2 Not later than 14 days after the posting of such notice the Member or organisation so charged may send to the General Secretary of the Association an answer thereto, and/or a written application for a hearing in accordance with Rule 42A.

- 3 The powers and duties of the National Council shall be exercised by a standing sub-committee called the Disciplinary Committee, consisting of 5 persons appointed by the Council at its first meeting after the Annual General Meeting to serve until their successors are appointed. Any member having an interest in the matter under consideration may be required to withdraw. The decisions of the Disciplinary Committee shall be published forthwith in the name of the Council.
- 4 In default of an application for a Hearing within the prescribed time, the matter shall be adjudicated taking into consideration such written representations or other evidence as may be thought fit.
- 5 Upon receipt of an application for a Hearing, the Member or organisation charged shall be given at least 14 days' notice of the date, place and time of the Hearing.
- 6 Where the allegation is against an organisation, any communication shall be addressed to the General Secretary of such organisation or other the person officially designated by such organisation to receive on its behalf official communications from the E.T.T.A., who shall also attend any Hearing on behalf of the organisation, unless some other person in place of the General Secretary be nominated in writing by the organisation.
- 7 Failure of any person involved to attend the Hearing, or to answer any question, or to produce any necessary papers, shall not prevent the Committee from proceeding to a decision.
- 8 Any Member charged, or the representative (designated by Regulation 6) of any organisation charged, may be accompanied at a Hearing by one other person of his choice, who shall not be a witness, and shall not (unless the person charged is under the age of 21 years) have the right to speak, but shall be entitled to make such record of the proceedings as he may think fit.
- 9 The Member or organisation charged shall have the right to give and call evidence in rebuttal of the charge and shall have the right to cross-examine any witnesses who give evidence in support of the charge.

No. 21. The Order of Service.

Throughout each game, except as provided in the second paragraph, the first five services shall be delivered by the selected partner of the pair who have the right to do so and shall be received by the appropriate partner of the opposing pair. The second five services shall be delivered by the partner of the server of the first five services and received by the partner of the receiver of the first five services. The third five services shall be delivered by the partner of the server of the first five services and received by the partner of the receiver of the first five services. The fourth five services shall be delivered by the partner of the server of the first five services and received by the partner of the receiver of the first five services. The fifth five services shall be delivered as the first five services. And so on, in sequence, until the end of the game or the score 20 all, when the sequence of serving and receiving shall be uninterrupted, but each player shall serve only one service in turn until the end of the game.

In a one game match, or in the deciding game of a match of more than one game when the score in games stands even, the receiving pair must alter its order of receiving when first either pair reaches the score 10.

Throughout the third game where there is no such alteration, up to the score 10 where there is such an alteration in it, and up to the score 10 in the fifth game, each partner shall receive from the opponent who served to him in the first game. Throughout the second and fourth games, and after the score 10 in the third or fifth game where such an alteration has occurred, each partner shall receive from the opponent to whom he served in the first game.

* the changes marked * operate until 1st July 1967 and will be reviewed by the I.T.T.F. Biennial General Meeting in 1967.

 "PUSHING PLAY" REGULATION

The old time-limit regulation has now finally been abolished and replaced by the "Expedite Law" the wording of which is contained in Regulation 8 on page 107 as amended

- 103 82 add new sentence to Reg. 1 (a) as follows:
 "If any lettering appears on the ends of tables, it should not be white; off-white would be suitable."

- 83 delete Reg. 1 (c) and insert:
 (c) The doubles centre line may be permanently marked in full length on the table. This is a convenience, and in no way invalidates the table for singles play.

- 104 84 delete Reg. 1 (g) and insert:
 (g) Measured at table height, the light shall be at least 400 lux in strength uniformly over the table, and not less than half the table strength over any other part of the playing area. The light source shall not be less than 4 metres from the ground. While general lighting alone is permissible if it gives this prescribed strength, wherever practicable a system providing special lighting over the table and playing area, and a contrasting relative darkness or less light outside the playing area is preferable in the interests of both players and spectators.

 "Players shall not wear white or light coloured clothing which might tend to distract or unsight the opponent. Any lettering, badge or pattern sufficiently large to break disturbingly the uniform dark colour of playing clothes is also objectionable for this reason. In all events under the Laws and Regulations for International Competitions, the following modification shall be added to the Laws of Table Tennis, Law 5.

If a game be unfinished fifteen minutes after its commencement, the umpire shall cause the game to be interrupted by declaration of a 'let', and the players shall be notified before the next service that the game in progress, and the remaining games of the match, will proceed under the following rule:

The player shall be permitted to hit the ball 12 times excluding the service stroke, and if all such strokes are safely returned by the opponent, one point shall be scored by the opponent.

The server for the point interrupted shall serve for the first point after the interruption, and thereafter the service shall alternate after each point. The lapse of the first fifteen minutes shall be noted by a timekeeper, acting under direction of the umpire, starting his timepiece when the first service is struck, and stopping and re-starting it for any interruption (such as the ball going out of court) as the umpire may direct. He shall advise the umpire when the fifteen minutes has elapsed and the call of 'let' is due. Counting shall be carried out by an official other than the umpire (e.g. the timekeeper) designated for this purpose the 'stroke counter'. He shall count the good returns of the receiver— one to thirteen. The numbers should preferably be announced out loud, distinctly and clearly, but not shouted, in the language of the country where the event takes place. (NOTE — this part of the Regulation shall operate until 1st July 1967). The umpire must call 'stop' if the rally continues afterwards."

87 after Reg. 8 insert:

Additional Regulations (currently Nos. 16 and 17), but to be adjusted in the course of I.T.T.F. Handbook revision.

- No. 16. "Captains and umpires should discourage players from mannerisms that are liable to distract or upset an opponent."
- No. 17. "When a ball other than the ball in play enters the playing space the umpire should promptly call a 'let'. Even if it should not appear to be inconveniencing the players at the moment, the course of the game may well take a turn which will bring the ball to the attention of one or other of the players, and make it a distraction. However, if a ball from another court should arrive just as a point is being won and in the opinion of the umpire it has had no effect whatever in the winning and losing of the point, he should in such case not declare a let". He should use his common sense and discretion in the matter."

REGULATIONS FOR NATIONAL JUNIOR TEAM COMPETITIONS

- 1 The competitions shall be open to junior boys and junior girls teams representing affiliated leagues, University clubs being considered as leagues for these competitions. All entries, with the entry fee of 10/- a team, must be received at the E.T.T.A. office not later than 15th September, in each season.
- 2 A league shall be represented in each tie by three players, each a member of that league taking part in the league competition. No player may represent more than one league in the competitions in one season. Each player must be a junior as defined by the E.T.T.A. (under 17 years of age on July 1st.)
- 3 In each round teams shall play each other in a tie of nine matches, each match being the best of three games. The tie may be ended by mutual agreement of the Captains and with the permission of the Referee, when one team has won five matches.
- 4 Before each tie the two Captains shall decide by lot the right of being A, B, C, or X, Y, Z, and each Captain shall then name his team to the Referee allotting a letter to each of his players. The order of play shall then be defined in Rule 5 and may be altered only by mutual agreement of the Captains and consent of the Referee.
- 5 The order of play shall be A v X, B v Y, C v Z, B v X, A v Z, C v Y, B v Z, C v X, A v Y. The interval, if any, should be taken after the fifth match.
- 6 The entrants shall be divided by the Committee into two areas, which shall be further divided into groups, and sub divided into zones, no zone containing more than eight entrants. The competitions shall be played on the knock-out system to determine successively zone winners, group winners and area winners, the area winners being the finalists of the competitions.
- 7 The draw for each zone, group and area, shall be made by the Committee and the result of each round shall be sent to all surviving entrants.
- 8 Except as provided in Regulation 12, the league drawn first in each tie except the final shall play at home unless both leagues agree to reverse the fixture or unless a combination is drawn that has occurred previously in the same competition, when the league playing away on the previous occasion may claim the right to play at home. The home league shall write to the Hon. Secretary of the Committee and the visiting league not later than 2 weeks before the date fixed for the round confirming its acceptance of the responsibility for staging the tie.
- 9 The closing date for all rounds shall be decided by the Committee at the beginning of each season, and notified to all participating leagues. The Committee shall have power to grant an extension of

the date for a tie in any round provided application is made to the Hon. Secretary of the Committee by both leagues before the closing date for that round. Extensions will be granted only if road and rail conditions preclude travelling and permission must be obtained from the Secretary of the Committee.

- 10 The home league shall offer the visiting league the choice of three dates, one of which shall be Saturday or Sunday, giving not less than one week's notice. The visiting league must accept one of these dates, failure to reach agreement being reported immediately to the Hon. Secretary of the Committee.
- 11 Except as provided in Regulation 12, in all rounds except the final each league shall be responsible for all expenses of its own team. The home league shall be responsible for the costs of staging the match and for providing refreshments for the visiting team.
- 12 If not less than three-quarters of the entrants in a zone agree, all the matches in that group may be played on one day at one venue, the expenses and receipts being shared equally among all the entrants agreeing to take part in the group play-off.
- 13 The final of each Competition shall be played on a date and at a venue selected by the Committee. The E.T.T.A. shall be responsible for the cost of staging the final and for the expenses of the participating teams up to an amount not exceeding the combined cost of second-class rail fare, hotel accommodation and breakfast for three persons in each team. Any profit made shall be divided 10% to each of the participating leagues, 10% to the league or affiliated body organising the staging of the tie, and the remainder to the E.T.T.A.
- 14 Ties must begin within 30 minutes of the previously appointed time. Any player not present when called upon by the Referee to play shall forfeit the match for which he is called. Any team playing with less than three players shall be liable to disciplinary action by the Committee.
- 15 The scores in each tie, signed by a representative of each team, shall be sent to the Hon. Secretary of the Committee within 2 days of the tie by the winning league. Failure to do so shall render the league responsible liable to disciplinary action by the Committee.
- 16 A Referee for each tie or zone play-off shall be appointed by the person or body responsible for staging the tie or group play-off.
- 17 The playing conditions for each tie shall be as defined in the current E.T.T.A. regulations for Open Tournaments, and the ball shall be any ball currently approved by the E.T.T.A.
- 18 The competitions shall be managed by a sub-committee, referred to in these rules as the Committee, who shall, be appointed each year by the National Council. The Committee's decision shall be final on all matters arising from these rules.

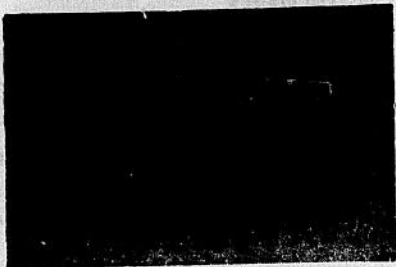

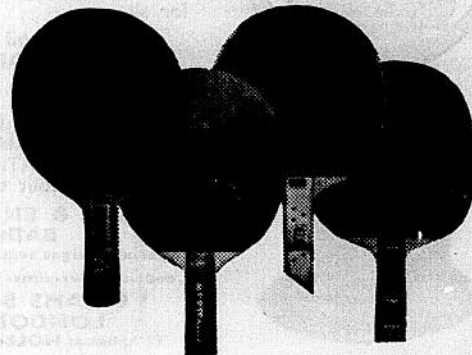

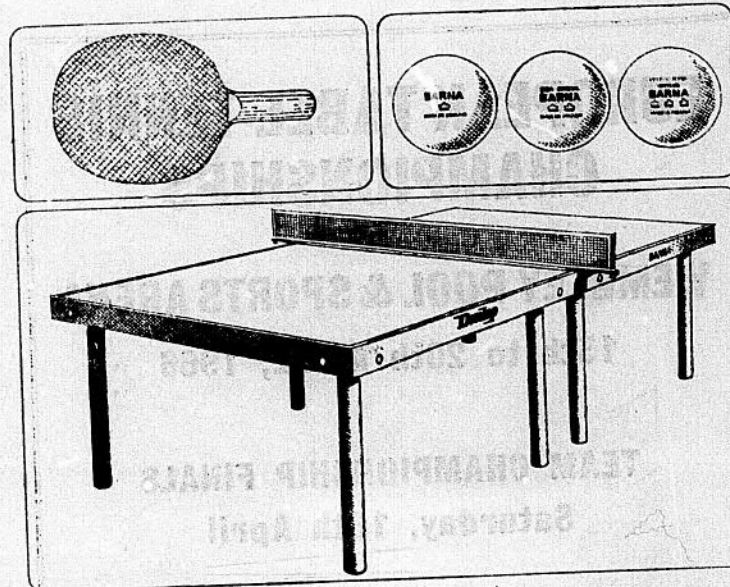
