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## RULES

(as at 4th July, 1971, plus alterations already passed for 1972/73)

### NAME

- 1 The Association shall be called the English Table Tennis Association.
- 2 The Association shall be affiliated to the International Table Tennis Federation.

### OBJECTS

- 3 The objects of the Association shall be as follows:
  - (a) To lay down and secure the adoption of uniform laws of the game of Table Tennis in England and to act as the legislative Authority.
  - (b) To decide all doubtful or disputed questions as to the laws and all matters relating to the game in England.
  - (c) To act as the sole controlling and governing body and generally to promote and encourage the playing, development and organisation of the game of Table Tennis in England.
  - (d) To apply solely to the promotion of the foregoing objects all income and property of the Association from whatever source derived.

### DEFINITIONS

- 4 (a) The following words and phrases shall throughout the Rules and Regulations of the Association have the meaning assigned to them by this Rule.
  - (1) affiliated club: a club in membership of a Local League.
  - (2) affiliated player: any player who is either a Directly Affiliated Individual or in membership of an affiliated body.
  - (3) Directly Affiliated Club: a club which pays an affiliation fee direct to the E.T.T.A., whether or not also in membership of a Local League.
  - (4) Directly Affiliated Individual: an individual who pays an affiliation fee direct to the E.T.T.A. whether or not also a member of a Directly Affiliated Club or of a club in membership of a Local League.
  - (5) Directly Affiliated School Club: a School Club which is accepted into direct affiliation with the E.T.T.A. whether or not also in membership of a league.
  - (6) division: a unit of a league which contains a number of teams.
  - (7) General Secretary: For the purposes of these Rules this shall include any person designated by the National Council to fulfil the functions of General Secretary.
  - (8) Junior: a person under 17 years of age on the preceding 30th June.
  - (9) Local League: any organisation or association which runs a competition between teams from clubs in a particular locality. Except where specifically excluded Local League includes Youth League.

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- (10) Member: any person mentioned in Rule 5(a), or any official, player or other member of a body mentioned in Rule 5(a), or of a club in membership of or affiliated to such a body.

- (11) Organisation in Good Standing: An organisation which has been given official recognition by the E.T.T.A. under Rule 5(b), being EITHER an organisation which is not a Table Tennis organisation, but under whose auspices Table Tennis is played, OR a Table Tennis organisation or competition which is not of a type mentioned in Rule 5(a).

- (12) Permit Member: a member of the Association duly registered under the provision of Rule 43 and the Permit Members Regulations in Appendix "A".

- (13) School Club: a club the membership of which is restricted to schoolchildren.

- (14) Schools League: a league consisting entirely of School Clubs.

- (15) Season: The period commencing the day after completion of an Annual General Meeting and ending on the day when the next Annual General Meeting is completed.

- (16) Youth Club: a club which is certified by a local Education Authority Youth Committee to be a youth club or accepted by the National Council as a youth club.

- (17) Youth League: a league the membership of which is restricted to persons under 21 years of age and consisting entirely of Youth Clubs or of Youth Clubs and School Clubs.

- (b) (1) Where the context so permits the masculine gender shall be taken to include the feminine.

- (2) Where the context so permits the singular shall include the plural and vice versa.

### CONSTITUTION

- 5 (a) The Association shall consist of:—
  - (i) President, Vice-Presidents, Honorary Life Members and duly elected Officers.
  - (ii) County Associations.
  - (iii) affiliated Local Leagues, Directly Affiliated Clubs and Directly Affiliated Individuals.
  - (iv) affiliated Schools Leagues and Directly Affiliated School Clubs.
- (b) Other organisations may be accepted into Good Standing at the discretion of the National Council.

### AFFILIATION

- 6 (a) No person or organisation shall be eligible to apply for affiliation unless playing under the Laws of Table Tennis as approved by the E.T.T.A.
- (b) The normal unit of affiliation shall be the Local League.

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- (c) Additionally, any club or individual eligible under Rule 6(a) may apply for affiliation.
- 7 (a) Every applicant for affiliation to the Association shall complete the current affiliation form and shall sign it on behalf of himself or of the league or club for which application is being made.
- (b) (i) Such form shall then be submitted to the appropriate County Association (if any) which shall indicate whether the application is approved or not.
- (ii) If approval of the application be not given or refused by the County Association within 28 days it shall be deemed refused.
- (iii) If approval of the application be refused or deemed refused the applicant may apply to the National Council for the approval of the County Association to be dispensed with. If such an application to the National Council be refused the applicant may appeal to the Board of Appeal.
- (iv) In the event of any application or appeal as mentioned in Rule 7(b) (iii) the County Association concerned shall provide a written statement of its reasons for not approving the application. If such statement is not provided the application or appeal shall forthwith be granted or allowed.
- (c) (i) Every application for affiliation approved by a County Association (if appropriate), or for which such approval shall have been dispensed with, shall be granted or refused by the Management Committee which shall have the power to refuse without giving reasons.
- (ii) An applicant may appeal to the National Council against refusal by the Management Committee. For the purpose of this rule refusal shall be deemed if the Management Committee has not accepted or refused within 28 days of the application being made or, if a County Association's consent be necessary within 28 days of such consent being given or dispensed with.
- (d) The procedure laid down by Rules 7(a) to (c) shall, unless resolved otherwise by the National Council, apply only to a first application for affiliation; renewal of affiliation shall be effected by sending the appropriate form direct to the E.T.T.A. General Secretary, and payments of the appropriate Affiliation Fees in due course.
- 8 (a) Every Local League, Directly Affiliated Club and Directly Affiliated Individual shall be deemed to remain affiliated until
- (i) Affiliation Fees due to the E.T.T.A. are unpaid on 30th April in any season, or
- (ii) Affiliation is terminated by the Local League, Directly Affiliated Club or Directly Affiliated Individual, or
- (iii) Renewal of Affiliation is refused by the National Council.
- (b) A Member by virtue of being an official, player or other member of a body mentioned in Rule 5(a), or of a club in membership of or affiliated to such a body shall be deemed to remain a Member until the earlier of

- (i) 31st December following the end of the season for which fees or subscription due were last paid by or in respect of him, or during which he was acknowledged by such body to be a member thereof, or
- (ii) the date on which his membership of that body is terminated by specific decision or operation of the Rules of that body.

#### AFFILIATION FEES

9 A Local League shall pay affiliation fees on the basis of the number of teams it has in membership, and the number of players required to make up a team in that league and to provide one reserve player per team.

10 The annual affiliation fees shall be as follows:

- (a) Local Leagues:
- (i) 12½p per team place, plus 12½p for one reserve place, for each team in a league other than a Youth League (i.e. 37½p for each team playing in a 2-a-side division, 50p for each team playing in a 3-a-side division and so on pro rata) except as provided in Rule 10(a) (iii).
- (ii) 6.25p per team place, plus 6.25p for one reserve place, for each team in a Youth League.
- (iii) 6.25p per team place, plus 6.25p for one reserve place, for each team which plays in a Local League division, membership of which division is restricted to persons under 21 years of age.
- (iv) For each club not participating in the league competition, 12½p per playing member.
- (v) Any Local League not affiliated to a County Association, shall pay an additional fee of 1.25p per team place, plus 1.25p for one reserve place per team.

- (ii) 9p per team place, plus 9p for one reserve place, for each team in a Youth League.
- (iii) 9p per team place, plus 9p for one reserve place, for each team which plays in a Local League division, membership of which division is restricted to persons under 21 years of age.
- (iv) For each club not participating in the league competition 18½p per playing member.
- (v) Any Local League not affiliated to a County Association shall pay an additional fee of 2p per team place, plus 2p for one reserve place per team.

**Calculation**—The number of team-places in a league shall be calculated by adding together the number of team-places in each division of that league; the number of team-places in a division shall be calculated by multiplying the number of teams in the division by the lowest number of players required by the rules to constitute a full team.

- (b) Directly Affiliated Clubs:
  - (i) £1.50 for each club affiliating directly, which is not a Youth Club.
  - (ii) 50p for each Youth Club affiliating directly.
- (c) Directly Affiliated Individuals £1.50.
- (d) Schools Leagues and Directly Affiliated School Clubs shall be affiliated without fee.
- (e) Other organisations accepted into Good Standing under Rule 5(b) may be required by the National Council to pay such fees as the National Council may determine.

- 11 All Affiliation Fees shall be paid to the General Secretary of the Association not later than 15th November each season.

#### UNPAID AFFILIATION FEES

- 12 (a) No Local League, which is under suspension by the E.T.T.A. or from or in respect of which any Affiliation Fees are due but unpaid shall be entitled to participate in any election of Officers or Councillors, nor to exercise any votes at a General Meeting, nor shall a County Association be entitled to exercise any votes in respect of such Local League, nor shall any member of such Local League be entitled to attend any General Meeting or take any part in the business of the Association.
- (b) No Local League from or in respect of which any Affiliation Fees are due to the E.T.T.A. but unpaid on 1st January, shall be entitled to nominate or vote in any election of Officers or National Councillors held between 1st January and the end of that season.

#### HANDBOOK

- 13 Copies of the Association's current Handbook when published shall be supplied free of charge to every County Association, Local League, Directly Affiliated Club, Directly Affiliated Individual and Permit Member.

#### PRESIDENT AND VICE-PRESIDENTS

- 14 (a) The Association shall have a President and not more than 30 Vice-Presidents who shall be elected by the Annual General Meeting.
- (b) The President or a Vice-President shall be elected for a term of three years, but shall be eligible for re-election at the end of such term.
- (c) Nominations for President and Vice-Presidents shall be submitted only by the National Council.

- (d) The President and Vice-Presidents shall hold office from the day following the A.G.M. at which they are elected.
- (e) The President shall have the right to attend all meetings of the Association including meetings of the National Council and of the Management Committee.

#### HONORARY LIFE VICE-PRESIDENT

- 15 (a) The Association may elect a Life Vice-President, but only past Presidents of the Association shall be eligible.
- (b) The distinction shall be conferred only at an Annual General Meeting.
- (c) Candidates shall be nominated only by the National Council.
- (d) The distinction shall carry with it the right to attend all General Meetings of the Association and the right to the Official Pass.

#### HONORARY LIFE MEMBERS

- 16 (a) The distinction of Honorary Life Member may be conferred for special or long service in connection with the game nationally.
- (b) The distinction shall be conferred only at an Annual General Meeting.
- (c) Candidates shall be nominated only by the National Council.
- (d) The distinction shall carry with it the right to attend all General Meetings of the Association and the right to the Official Pass.

#### OFFICERS

- 17 (a) The honorary Officers of the Association shall be Chairman, Deputy Chairman, General Secretary (if the post be not suspended in the manner mentioned in Rule 17(e)) and Treasurer.
- (b) All Officers shall retire annually at the end of the Annual General Meeting, but shall be eligible for re-election.
- (c) A casual vacancy in an office shall be filled in the manner set out in Rule 19 so far as applicable, the nomination forms being sent out not later than 21 days after the vacancy occurs.
- (d) Notice of intention not to seek re-election to any Office should be sent to reach the General Secretary not later than January 31st in any year.
- (e) Should the National Council under the provisions of Rule 21 appoint a paid General Secretary, the office of honorary General Secretary shall be suspended whilst such appointment is in effect.
- (f) No person may hold more than one office at the same time.

#### ELECTORAL REGISTER

- 18 (a) For the purpose of elections the General Secretary shall not later than 10th January send to the Secretary of every County Association and Local League a list, to be referred to as the Electoral Register, of all Local Leagues whose Affiliation Fees were paid on 1st January. Any challenge to the accuracy of the Electoral Register must be made in writing and received by the General Secretary not later than 20th January or within 7 days of notification of any addition, transfer or deletion.



- (b) The Electoral Register shall be divided into sections, one for each County Association, in which shall be listed the Local Leagues entitled to vote in the election of National Councillor for that County.
- (c) The name of any Local League suspended by the E.T.T.A. shall be removed from the Electoral Register forthwith, but shall be restored as soon as the suspension ends.
- (d) The name of any Local League which ceases to be affiliated shall be removed from the Electoral Register forthwith.
- (e) Between the end of a season and 31st of December following the General Secretary shall add to the Electoral Register the name of any newly affiliated Local League.
- (f) No Local League shall without the authority of the National Council be transferred from one County section to another in, nor, except as provided by Rule 18(e), added to, nor, except as provided by Rules 18(c) and (d), removed from the Electoral Register.

#### ELECTION OF OFFICERS

- 19 (a) By a date to be decided by the National Council (not being later than 16th March nor earlier than 2nd March) the General Secretary shall send a Nomination Paper to the Secretary of every County Association and to the Secretary of every Local League listed in the Electoral Register under Rule 18.
- (b) Each County or Local League shall be entitled to nominate one person for each office to be filled.
- (c) To be valid a nomination paper must:
  - (i) be signed by the Secretary and by another responsible officer of such County Association or Local League, and be received by the Nominations Officer (being the General Secretary of the Association or such other person as may be appointed for the purpose by the Management Committee) not later than 14 days after the issue of the nomination papers.
  - (ii) No person will be effectively nominated unless he is named in at least two valid nomination papers.
- (e) Voting for the election of the Officers of the Association shall be by postal ballot (if there be more than one effective nomination for any office) which shall be conducted in such a manner as the National Council may from time to time determine.
- (f) The vote of each County shall count as 1 unit, the vote of each Local League with 30 or less teams in membership 1 unit, 31-100 teams in membership 2 units and 101 or more teams in membership 3 units. For the purpose of this Rule a Local League shall be deemed to have in membership the number of teams it had in membership at the previous 1st January or at the beginning of the current season whichever is the later. No Local League shall be entitled to vote which is not in the Electoral Register.
- (g) Every voting paper shall be signed by the Secretary and another responsible Officer of the organisation voting.

- (h) Scrutineers shall be appointed by the National Council to determine any questions as to the validity of nomination and voting papers, and ascertain the result of any postal vote held under the provisions of this rule.
- (i) The result of the election of Officers shall be circulated concurrently with the nomination papers for the election of National Councillors under Rule 23(a).

#### OFFICIALS

- 20 The National Council shall at its discretion have authority to elect additional honorary officials for up to one year and to invite such persons to attend meetings of the National Council, but, unless they already be members of the Council, without right to speak (unless invited to do so) and without vote.

#### PAID APPOINTMENTS

- 21 (a) The National Council shall have power to create and fill any paid appointment which in its opinion is necessary.
- (b) The National Council shall approve any contract necessary in connection with such paid appointment and shall authorise the Officers to sign it on behalf of the Association. The contract shall thereupon be binding upon the Association.
- (c) No person holding a paid appointment with the Association may be an honorary Officer of the Association or a National Councillor.

#### NATIONAL COUNCIL

- 22 (a) The Association shall, subject to the control of the Annual General Meeting, be governed by a National Council which shall consist of the Officers of the Association (as defined by Rule 17(a)) together with one person representing each County Association elected annually in the manner laid down by Rule 23.
- (b) No Councillor may represent more than one County.
- (c) No E.T.T.A. Officer may represent a County as its Councillor.
- (d) Every Councillor shall retire annually at the end of the Annual General Meeting but shall be eligible for re-election.
- (e) In the event of a Council seat becoming vacant, it shall be filled by election in the manner laid down by Rule 23 so far as applicable.
- (f) The quorum necessary for the transaction of business by the Council shall be fifteen members with the right to vote.
- (g) Except as herein otherwise provided, every question at a meeting of the Council shall be determined by a majority of the votes of the members present and voting, every member having one vote, and in the case of an equality of votes the chairman of the meeting shall have a second or casting vote. The President shall not be entitled to vote.
- (h) The Council may delegate any of its duties and powers to the Management Committee or any Sub-Committee.



- (i) Standing Orders for the Management Committee shall be subject to approval by the Council.
- (j) The Council may appoint sub-committees consisting of such person as it thinks fit, which shall, in the performance of their duties, conform to any regulations that may be imposed on them by the Council and shall report to the Management Committee.
- (k) The administration of the Rules and Regulations of the Association shall be vested in the Council who shall (subject to Rule 22(h)):
  - (i) Decide questions of laws and other matters relating to the game but cannot alter the Rules of the Association.
  - (ii) Decide matters relating to international and representative matches, teams, conferences, etc., as affecting the Association.
  - (iii) Sanction Open Tournaments, Invitation Tournaments or general Competitions.
  - (iv) Decide all questions under Rule 55.
- (l) The Council shall have the power to make regulations to cover international contacts, regulation dress and badges and such other matters not specifically dealt with in these Rules as the Council shall think fit. Such regulations shall be published as appendices to these Rules.
- (m) At the first meeting of the Council after the Annual General Meeting it shall agree its Standing Orders for the coming period of office.
- (n) The Council shall hold a meeting within fifteen days after the Annual General Meeting, at which meeting Management Committee members shall be elected as provided by Rule 25.
- (o) The Council shall hold a minimum of three meetings every season.

#### ELECTION OF NATIONAL COUNCIL

- 23 (a) By a date to be decided by the National Council (not being later than 7th May nor earlier than 23rd April) the General Secretary shall send a Nomination Paper to the Secretary of every Local League listed in the Electoral Register under Rule 18.
- (b) Each Local League shall be entitled to nominate a person to be National Councillor for the County Association of which such Local League is in membership.
- (c) To be valid a nomination paper must:
  - (i) be signed on behalf of the Local League or County Association by the Secretary and another responsible officer thereof, and
  - (ii) be received by the Nominations Officer (being the General Secretary of the Association or such other person as may be appointed for the purpose by the Management Committee) not later than 14 days after issue of the nomination papers.
- (d) No person will be effectively nominated unless he is named in at least two valid nomination papers. Exceptionally, where there is only one Local League in membership with the County Association, one valid nomination shall suffice.

- (e) No person may accept nomination for more than one seat at the same time.
- (f) If there be more than one person effectively nominated to represent any County Association, there shall be a postal ballot of the Local Leagues in membership of that County Association carried out in such a manner as shall be determined by the National Council.
- (g) The vote of each Local League having 30 or less teams in the League shall count as one unit, each Local League having 31 to 100 teams as two units, and each Local League having more than 100 teams three units. For the purpose of this Rule a Local League shall be deemed to have in membership the number of teams it had in membership at the previous 1st January or at the beginning of the current season whichever is the later. No Local League shall be entitled to vote which is not in the Electoral Register.
- (h) Each Local League's voting paper shall be signed by the Secretary and by another responsible officer of such League.
- (i) Scrutineers shall be appointed by the National Council to determine any questions as to the validity of nomination and voting papers, and to ascertain the result of any postal vote held under the provisions of this Rule.
- (j) A list of the National Councillors elected shall be circulated not later than 24th June.
- (k) In the event of there being no effective nomination from any County by the date provided by Rule 23(c) (ii), the Nominations Officer shall by a date determined by the Council (which date shall not be later than 14th June) inform the Secretary of such County Association, which shall then be entitled to nominate a person to be its Councillor for the following season, such nomination being effective if received by the Nominations Officer in writing by a date determined by the Council (which date shall not be later than 20th June.)
- (l) In the event of there being no effective nomination under Rule 23(d) or 23(k) for any seat that seat shall remain vacant for the season.
- (m) In the event of the ballot resulting in a tie, there shall be a second ballot. In the event of the second ballot also resulting in a tie, the Chairman of the County Association shall exercise a casting vote.

#### MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

- 24 (a) There shall be a Management Committee to manage the affairs of the Association in accordance with the policy and directions of the National Council.
- (b) Such Committee shall consist of the Officers and four other National Council members elected by the National Council in the manner laid down by Rule 25.
- (c) Committee members (other than the Officers) shall retire on the election of their successors at the first Council meeting after the Annual General Meeting. Committee members shall be eligible for re-election.



- (d) Any casual vacancy occurring in the Committee shall be filled in the manner laid down by Rule 25 as far as applicable.
- (e) The quorum necessary for the transaction of business by the Committee shall be four, including at least one Officer.
- (f) Except as herein otherwise provided, every question at a meeting of the Committee shall be determined by a majority of the votes of members present and voting, every member having one vote, and in the case of an equality of votes the chairman of the meeting shall have a second or casting vote. The President shall not be entitled to vote.
- (g) The Standing Orders for the Management Committee shall be as approved by the National Council under Rule 22(i).

#### ELECTION OF MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

- 25 (a) The four members of the Management Committee other than the Officers shall be elected by secret ballot of the National Council.
- (b) The ballot shall be held at the first meeting of the National Council after the Annual General Meeting (hereinafter referred to as "the Election Meeting").
- (c) A nomination paper shall be given to every member of the Council present.
- (d) Each member shall be entitled to nominate up to four persons.
- (e) No person will be effectively nominated unless he is named in at least two papers.
- (f) Each member of the National Council shall vote for four persons, no more, no less.
- (g) The four persons receiving the highest number of votes shall be declared elected. If an equality of votes results in there not being four persons with a clear majority over the other candidates, then those who have such clear majority shall be declared elected, and a fresh ballot shall be held for the remaining seat or seats, for which only candidates unsuccessful in the previous ballot shall be eligible.
- (h) Scrutineers shall be appointed by the Annual General Meeting to determine any question as to the validity of nomination and voting papers and ascertain the result of the ballot.

#### FINANCE

- 26 The financial year of the Association shall end on 31st May, and an audited statement of accounts up to and including this date shall be published annually.
- 27 The Auditors shall be elected by the Annual General Meeting and shall take office from the day following that meeting.
- 28 The funds of the Association shall be lodged at a bank, and all cheques, drafts, etc., drawn on the account shall be signed by the Treasurer and by either the Chairman or General Secretary.

- 29 If at any time the National Council shall procure the registration under the Companies Act, 1948, of a company limited by guarantee having among its objects, objects similar to those of the Association, the National Council shall have the power to transfer and pay over to such company without consideration the whole of the property and assets of the Association (after payment of or provision for the liabilities of the Association) and after such transfer and payment over to declare by resolution that the Association is dissolved. Any such transfer and payment shall be valid and binding upon all parties interested and such declaration shall be effective.

- 30 If upon the winding up or dissolution of the Association there remains, after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the Association, but shall be given or transferred to some other institution or institutions having objects similar to the objects of the Association and if effect cannot be given to such provision then to some other purposes approved by the Commissioners of Customs and Excise.

#### ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

- 31 (a) The Annual General Meeting of the Association shall be held in the first or second week in July.
- (b) Notice specifying the place, the date and hour together with the Agenda, shall be given to the Secretary of every County Association, Local League and Directly Affiliated Club and to every Directly Affiliated Individual not later than 1st June.
- (c) Attendance at the A.G.M. shall be open to all Members (except as mentioned in Rule 12(a)).
- (d) Each County Association, and each Local League which has exercised the option under Rule 32(a), shall be entitled to appoint an Accredited Representative who shall hold the official Voting Card issued by the E.T.T.A. signed by the Secretary of his County Association or Local League.
- (e) The Agenda for the Annual General Meeting shall include the following items:
  - (i) To adopt Standing Orders for the meeting.
  - (ii) To read the minutes of the previous Annual General Meeting.
  - (iii) To consider any matters arising therefrom.
  - (iv) To read the minutes of any Special General Meeting held since the previous Annual General Meeting.
  - (v) To consider any matters arising from (iv).
  - (vi) To receive and consider the Annual Report of the National Council.
  - (vii) To receive and consider the Report of the Treasurer, the Report of the Auditors and the Statement of Accounts made up to May 31st or a subsequent date.
  - (viii) To consider and determine any alterations to Rules.
  - (ix) To consider any other Motions.
  - (x) To elect the President and Vice-Presidents if appropriate.



- (xi) To elect Honorary Life Members of the Association.
- (xii) To elect Scrutineers for the next Management Committee election.
- (xiii) To elect Auditors for the ensuing year.
- (xiv) To receive the Report of the Election of Officers.
- (xv) To receive the Report of the Election of National Councillors.
- (xvi) To consider any other competent business.
- (f) Before transacting any business the A.G.M. shall adopt Standing Orders which shall govern procedure at the meeting.
- (g) Motions relating to the Rules of the Association or the Laws of Table Tennis as approved by the Association may be proposed only by the National Council or by a County Association or a Local League.
- (h) On every motion the Chairman shall test the feeling of the meeting by a show of hands of Accredited Representatives, and shall declare the number of hands shown for and against. Unless a Block Vote is demanded under Rule 31(i) or the Chairman himself decide to proceed to a Block Vote, he shall declare the motion carried or lost according to the show of hands, each Accredited Representative having one vote.
- (i) The Chairman shall accept a demand for a Block Vote (i) in the case of a motion as specified in Rule 31(g) from any Accredited Representative or (ii) in the case of any other motion from not less than 6 Accredited Representatives, or may himself decide to proceed to a Block Vote on any motion.
- (j) Block Vote: In Block Voting each County Association's Accredited Representative shall exercise the votes of every Local League in his County except any Local League which has exercised the Option given by Rule 32(a), or any Local League as mentioned in Rule 12(a). The Accredited Representative of a Local League which has exercised the Option given by Rule 32(a) shall exercise the votes of his Local League. Each Local League shall be entitled to one vote for each team in membership.
- (k) A majority in excess of opposition of one-third of the votes cast shall be necessary to carry any resolution in respect of the Rules of the Association and the Laws of Table Tennis. Other resolutions shall be decided by simple majority, and, in the event of a tie, except on financial questions, the meeting shall proceed to the next business. In the matter of finance the chairman shall have a casting vote.

#### VOTING BY LOCAL LEAGUES AT GENERAL MEETINGS

- 32 (a) Any Local League wishing to exercise its own votes at a General Meeting shall give notice in writing to the General Secretary of the Association of its desire so to do not later than 14 days before the date of the General Meeting, such notice being signed by the Secretary and by another responsible officer of the Local League. The General Secretary shall issue an official Voting Card to the Secretary of such Local League not later than seven days before the date of the meeting.

- (b) The votes of every Local League which does not exercise the option granted by Rule 32(a) shall be exercised by the Accredited Representative of the County Association to which such Local League belongs.

#### SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING

- 33 (a) A Special General Meeting of the Association shall be convened on a resolution of the National Council, or within one month of receipt by the General Secretary of a request signed by the authorised representatives of at least one third of the Local Leagues.
- (b) Rule 31 respecting circulation of notices and procedure shall apply as for the Annual General Meeting so far as applicable, at least 28 days' notice being given.

#### COUNTY ADMINISTRATION

- 34 (a) Where a majority of affiliated Local Leagues in any County agree, a body shall be set up for the purpose of administration in the County.
- (b) (i) The administrative area of a County Association shall be defined primarily by the geographical boundaries of the County in force for the time being.
- (ii) There shall be no County of London, but for the purpose of these Rules the Greater London area shall be divided as follows:  
The London Boroughs of Bexley, Bromley, Greenwich and Lewisham shall be part of Kent.  
The London Boroughs of Barking, Havering, Newham, Redbridge and Waltham Forest shall be part of Essex.  
The London Boroughs of Croydon, Kingston-upon-Thames, Lambeth, Merton, Richmond-upon-Thames, Southwark, Sutton and Wandsworth shall be part of Surrey.  
The London Boroughs of Barnet, Brent, Camden, Ealing, Enfield, Hackney, Hammersmith, Haringey, Harrow, Hillingdon, Hounslow, Islington, Kensington and Chelsea, Tower Hamlets and Westminster and the City of London shall constitute the County of Middlesex.
- 35 (a) (i) A Local League shall affiliate to one County Association only, and shall not transfer or be required to transfer its affiliation from one County Association to another at any time, except as provided in Rule 35(b).
- (ii) A Local League affiliating newly or afresh shall affiliate to the County Association in whose geographical area all or the largest number of its member clubs is situated at the time of application, except as provided in Rules 35(a) (iii) and (iv).
- (iii) Where a Local League affiliating newly or afresh has member clubs situated in the geographical areas of two or more County Associations and EITHER it wishes to



- affiliate to one of those County Associations other than that determined by Rule 35(a) (ii) OR at the time of the application there is no one County Association in the geographical area of which a larger number of its member clubs is situated than in any other County THEN such a Local League may apply to the National Council for permission to affiliate to a County Association of its choice in whose geographical area some of its member clubs are situated. The National Council shall decide such application taking into consideration the views of the Local League and of every County Association in whose geographical area any of the Local League's member clubs is situated.
- (iv) Notwithstanding the provisions of Rule 35(a) (ii) a Local League may with the consent of the County Association to which it would be required to affiliate under Rule 35(a) (ii) apply to the National Council for permission to affiliate to some other County Association.
  - (b) Where changes in the membership of a Local League having member clubs situated in the geographical area of two or more County Associations result in an alteration of the distribution of its member clubs among the geographical areas of such County Associations either the Local League or any of such County Associations may apply to the National Council to approve a transfer of the affiliation of the Local League to some other County Association. The National Council shall decide such application taking into consideration the views of the Local League and of every County Association in whose geographical area any of the Local League's member clubs is situated.
  - (c) A Local League continuously affiliated to a County Association other than that defined by Rule 35(a) (i) since before 18th January 1964, shall have the right to continue to affiliate to that Association.
  - (d) (i) Membership of or affiliation to such County Association shall be compulsory for all Local Leagues, Directly Affiliated Clubs, Directly Affiliated Individuals, Schools Leagues and Directly Affiliated School Clubs in the County, except as provided under Rules 34 and 35.  
(ii) All organisations in the County in Good Standing with the E.T.T.A. shall be accepted into Good Standing by the County Association.
  - (e) Not later than 30th November each season every County Association shall send to the E.T.T.A. (i) a list of all Local Leagues affiliated to the County Association at the date of the list and (ii) a list of Local Leagues which were so affiliated the previous season but have not renewed their affiliation by the date of the list.
  - (f) In any case where the National Council may decide that a Local League shall not be obliged to affiliate to a County Association, either (1) because no County Association exists in the County concerned or (2) because membership of the Local League

concerned is spread over more than one County, an additional fee of 1.25p per team place for each team in membership with the said Local League shall be paid to the E.T.T.A. Money so received in case (1) shall be passed to the appropriate County Association if one be formed during the year to which payment relates, but shall otherwise become ordinary E.T.T.A. income. Money so received in case (2) shall be divided in such a manner as the National Council may decide among the County Associations in whose areas the Local League concerned operates.

- 36 No person or body may affiliate to a County Association unless affiliated to the E.T.T.A., but a club or individual may affiliate direct to the County Association without affiliating direct to the E.T.T.A. provided that it or he is affiliated to the E.T.T.A. through a Local League or Directly Affiliated Club.
- 37 (a) The Constitution and Regulations of each County Association and any amendments thereto shall not be valid unless approved by the National Council. Such approval shall be retrospective to the date on which application for approval was made.  
(b) The Rules of a County Association shall contain such matters as the Council shall from time to time decide as specified in Appendix 'J' to these Rules.
- 38 (a) A County Association shall have complete autonomy in organising and administering the game in the county but shall have no power to alter the laws of the game or the rules and regulations of the Association or to over-ride the decisions of the National Council.  
(b) A County Association shall have power to organise Open and Invitation Tournaments (subject to the sanction of the National Council), Closed Tournaments, County Leagues, County Championships, Inter-League matches and Inter-County Championships. They shall also have power, in conjunction with other County Associations, to run representative matches, leagues, etc.
- 39 (a) A County Association shall have power to suspend any Local League, club, player or official within its jurisdiction, and such suspension shall be enforced by all bodies in that County and shall be notified to the General Secretary of the E.T.T.A.  
(b) On the application of the County Association, the National Council may make the suspension national.  
(c) Any such suspension shall be subject to a right of appeal to the Board of Appeal.
- 40 A County Association shall be entitled to receive each season from the E.T.T.A.:



- (i) { a rebate of 20 per cent in respect of Affiliation Fees paid to the E.T.T.A. by 31st March by Local Leagues, Directly Affiliated Clubs and Directly Affiliated Individuals in membership with such County Association and
- 1971-72 {
- (i) { A rebate of 13½ per cent in respect of Affiliation Fees paid to the E.T.T.A. by 31st March by Local Leagues, Directly Affiliated Clubs and Directly Affiliated Individuals in membership with such County Association and
- 1972-73 {
- (ii) A rebate of 20 per cent of the competitors' fees paid to the E.T.T.A. in respect of Tournaments played within the area of such County Association and
- (iii) a rebate of 20 per cent of the fees paid by 31st March by all Permit Members whose application forms were countersigned on behalf of such County Association.

#### GENERAL AND DISCIPLINARY

- 41 No affiliated player or club may take part in competition with any player or club, or in exhibition at any club, or under any auspices, not registered or affiliated to the English Table Tennis Association, without the sanction of the County Secretary concerned.
- 42 No Member or affiliated organisation shall play Table Tennis with or against or take part in any Table Tennis function in conjunction with any suspended organisation or Member.
- 43 Permit Members
- (a) No payment other than expenses shall be made to or received by any Member for playing, coaching, umpiring, writing, filming, broadcasting, televising, or for exhibitions or in relation to equipment unless he has been duly registered as a Permit Member or has received specific exemption from registration from the National Council.
- (b) Any affiliated association or club making a payment in excess of expenses must, if required by the E.T.T.A. General Secretary, or by the General Secretary of the appropriate County Association, report the payment, specifying the amount and the services rendered, within 14 days of such a requisition being received.
- (c) The National Council shall have power to make regulations governing the registration and conduct of Permit Members which regulations shall be included in Appendix 'A' to these Rules.
- 44 (a) Except as provided by Rule 44(b) no affiliated player shall be paid or receive any remuneration other than expenses (return fare, hotel accommodation and meals), or reward (other than permitted prizes) for playing in any competitive Table Tennis event, that is an event in which the player is playing for his Club,

- League, County or Country against another Club, League, County or Country, or in an Open, Invitation, Closed or other Tournament. Trial matches organised by Club, League, County or the Association for the purpose of selecting representative teams shall be deemed competitive events.
- (b) (i) Subject to the consent of the National Council (which in the case of an Open Tournament shall be implied on consent being given to hold the Open Tournament) prizes not exceeding £25 or to a value not exceeding £25 may be awarded and accepted.
- (ii) Prizes exceeding £25 but not exceeding £100 in value (or not exceeding such lesser sum as the National Council may stipulate) may be awarded and accepted only with the specific permission of the National Council.
- (iii) No prize may exceed £100 in value.
- (iv) For the purpose of this Rule "prize" means the total of all awards won by a player in one event.

- 45 Notwithstanding the provisions of Rule 44 badges and colours may be awarded and accepted for participation in representative matches.
- 46 No affiliated player may permit a cinematographic record of himself or herself to be taken in connection with Table Tennis for public exhibition unless sanction has first been obtained from the General Secretary of the Association.
- 47 No affiliated player may enter into a contract in return for capitalising his skill at table tennis without the sanction of the National Council.
- 48 No affiliated player may enter into a contract providing for his exclusive use of certain materials or exclusive play on certain premises controlled by a firm, in any circumstances.
- 49 No affiliated player, organiser or official may take part in a televised event in connection with table tennis unless sanction has first been obtained from the General Secretary of the Association or the event is one authorised by the Association.
- 50 A person gainfully connected with table tennis may occupy an administrative office, or serve on an administrative committee of the Association only provided that he is prepared to withdraw from any meeting or abstain from voting on any issue, on request formally passed by a majority of the meeting he is attending.
- 51 Betting in any shape or form on players or matches is strictly prohibited.
- 52 In all tournaments and matches sanctioned by the National Council, players are prohibited from wearing white or light coloured clothes that might, in the opinion of the duly appointed referee, tend to unsight an opponent.



[Recommendation adopted at A.G.M., April, 1952: All competitors are strongly recommended to wear a sports shirt or other top of single colour (except for the badge, of reasonable size), trousers, skirts, or shorts of single colour and rubber shoes. All counties, leagues, local associations and clubs are requested to use their best endeavours to secure compliance with this recommendation. Players representing the Association in an International or other representative match must wear the regulation dress as instructed by the National Council.]

53 Only a brand and grade of ball approved by the National Council may be used in play within, between or organised by any organisations which are affiliated or in Good Standing.

#### 54 Misconduct

- (a) Any player having accepted selection by the Association to attend any international match or other event and without good and sufficient cause either refusing to comply with the arrangements of the National Council or any of its sub-committees for playing the match or event, or failing to attend the same, may be adjudged by the National Council to have been guilty of misconduct, and any Member adjudged to have encouraged such player to commit a breach of instruction or rule shall be deemed guilty of a like offence.
- (b) In the event of any act, statement, writing, conduct or matter not provided for elsewhere, which, in the opinion of the National Council is likely to bring the game of Table Tennis into disrepute, the National Council may request the Member responsible for such act, statement, writing, conduct or matter (hereinafter called "the offender") to give a written undertaking not to repeat such act, statement, writing, conduct or matter, nor to do or commit any similar act, statement, writing, conduct or matter. In default of such undertaking being given within seven days from the sending of a written request to the offender, or if such undertaking is given and there is any breach thereof, then such default or breach shall be misconduct.
- (c) The National Council shall have the power to resolve that any such act, statement, writing, conduct or matter as is mentioned in Rule 54(b) is in itself misconduct and shall be dealt with as such.
- (d) The National Council shall have the power to resolve that any breach of a Regulation of an Open Tournament duly approved by the E.T.T.A. shall constitute misconduct.
- (e) Failure of any Member without good and sufficient cause to attend the Hearing of any allegation or appeal after having been requested with reasonable notice so to do, or failure without good and sufficient cause to answer any question put to him in connection with such allegation or appeal shall be deemed misconduct.

55 Upon any breach of these Rules or of the Regulations made thereunder or on any misconduct as defined in these Rules being proved to the satisfaction of the National Council, the Council shall have power to order the Member or organisation guilty of such a breach or misconduct (the offender).

- (i) To be suspended either indefinitely or for a stated period.
- (ii) To be fined (either in addition to suspension or not).
- (iii) To be censured.
- (iv) To be dealt with in such other manner as the National Council may think fit.

There shall be no appeal against such decision.

56 Any Member or organisation charged with any breach or misconduct shall be furnished with details in writing of such charge and shall have the right to a personal Hearing or to make written representations.

57 The procedure for dealing with any allegation of breach of Rule or Regulation or misconduct shall be determined by the National Council and shall be included in Appendix 'E' to these Rules.

#### APPEALS

58 Any individual or club aggrieved by a decision or action of a Local League, or a Committee or Officer of such League, may appeal against any such decision or action to the County Association to which such Local League is affiliated, or if there be no such County Association, to the National Council of the E.T.T.A., and the decision of the body to which the appeal is made shall be final and binding on all parties.

- 59 (a) Any individual, club or Local League aggrieved by a decision or action of a County Association, or a Committee or Officer of such Association (except the determination of an Appeal) or any individual, club, Local League or County Association aggrieved by a decision or action of the E.T.T.A., or the National Council, or a Committee or Officer of the E.T.T.A. (except a decision under Rule 56), may appeal against any such decision or action to the Board of Appeal of the E.T.T.A.
- (b) The Board of Appeal shall consist of eight persons appointed by the National Council but not being members of the Council.
- (c) The procedure for matters being dealt with by the Board of Appeal shall be determined by the Board and a copy of the Regulations governing such procedure shall be supplied to any organisation or Member making any appeal under these Rules and to any Respondent to any such Appeal.
- (d) Each appeal shall be determined by three members of the Board of Appeal selected by the Management Committee, who shall also designate one of the three as Chairman.



- (e) The Board shall decide the appeal, except that, where the appeal would be upheld on a technicality only, or due to a procedural irregularity by the body appealed against, then the Board may remit the matter to be dealt with afresh by the body appealed against, with a direction regarding the technicality or procedural irregularity.
- (f) Where the appeal is against disciplinary action the Board shall have the power to vary the punishment imposed.
- (g) The decision of the Board shall be final and binding on all parties.
- (h) The decision of the Board shall be published forthwith, and a written minute of the decision shall be sent to the appellant and all other parties to the appeal.

60 Any such appeal (as provided for by Rules 58 and 59) shall be made in writing to the General Secretary of the appropriate body within 21 days of the decision or action appealed against, and shall be accompanied by a fee of 50p in the case of an individual or £2 in the case of an organisation which shall be returned if the adjudicating body consider the making of an appeal to have been justified (whatever the result). Either party to the appeal shall be entitled to be heard by the adjudicating body, both in person, and, if so desired, additionally by a representative who shall have been nominated in writing.

61 Whilst any appeal is pending the decision against which the appeal has been made shall not have effect. An appeal shall be deemed to be pending from the time notice of appeal is received by the appropriate person.

62 The Rules of the Association being sufficient to enable the National Council, as the governing body of the game of Table Tennis in England, or the Board of Appeal to deal with all cases of dispute, legal proceedings shall be taken only as a last resort, after the full procedure laid down by these Rules and any Regulations made thereunder shall have been followed through.

63 The Association shall be entitled to publish in the public press, or in any other manner it shall think fit, reports of its proceedings, acts and resolutions, whether the same shall or shall not, reflect upon the character or conduct of any league, club or Member, and every such league, club or Member shall be deemed to have assented to such publication.

#### JUNIOR AGE LIMIT

64 In all competitions run by or approved by any affiliated body the term 'Junior' shall have the meaning assigned to it by Rule 4(a) (8).

#### TOURNAMENTS

65 (a) The National Council shall have power to make regulations defining categories of tournaments, and governing the conduct and organisation of such tournaments as may be specified. Such regulations shall be included in Appendix 'B' to these Rules.

- (b) Every tournament shall come within one of the categories defined by the National Council in Appendix 'B', and the National Council shall have power to decide in which category any particular tournament shall be placed.
- (c) No Open or Invitation Tournament shall be held without the sanction of the National Council. Application for running an Open or Invitation Tournament shall be submitted to the appropriate County Association (if any) who shall forward the application to the National Council with their recommendations.

#### ENGLISH OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS

66 The English Open Championships may be held once every year and when so held:

- (a) The date and venue shall be fixed and notice of same circulated as in Rule 31(b) not later than December 31st each year.
- (b) Twelve Championships shall be held as follows: Men's Singles, Men's Doubles, Women's Singles, Women's Doubles, Mixed Doubles, Junior Singles (Boys), Junior Singles (Girls), Junior Doubles (Boys), Junior Doubles (Girls), Junior Mixed Doubles and Men's and Women's Veteran's Singles, and in addition a Men's and Women's Consolation Singles event for competitors eliminated in the first two played rounds of the Singles Championships. A walkover but not a bye shall rank as a played round. It shall be in the power of the National Council to decide, in any year, to hold Junior Championships events separately from the Senior Championships.
- (c) All matches in the Championships shall be best of five games, with the exception of the Junior Singles (Boys), Junior Singles (Girls), Junior Doubles (Boys), Junior Doubles (Girls), Junior Mixed Doubles, Veterans' and Consolation events, which shall be best of three games.
- (d) Such of the regulations in Part II of Appendix 'B' as are specified in Part IV of Appendix 'B' shall apply to the English Open Championships.

#### ENGLISH CLOSED CHAMPIONSHIPS

67 The English Closed Championships may be held once every year and when so held:

- (a) Twelve Championships shall be held as follows: Men's Singles, Men's Doubles, Women's Singles, Women's Doubles, Mixed Doubles, Junior Singles (Boys), Junior Singles (Girls), Junior Doubles (Boys), Junior Doubles (Girls), Junior Mixed Doubles and Men's and Women's Veteran's Singles. In addition, a Men's and Women's Consolation Singles shall be held for competitors eliminated in the first two played rounds of the Singles Championships. A walkover, but not a bye, shall rank as a played round. It shall be in the power of the National Council to hold Junior Championships separately from the Senior Championships.



- (b) All matches in the Championships shall be best of five games with the exception of the Junior Singles (Boys), Junior Singles (Girls), Junior Doubles (Boys), Junior Doubles (Girls), Junior Mixed Doubles and Veterans and Consolation events, which shall be best of three games.
- (c) Such of the regulations in Part V of Appendix 'B' as are specified in Part V of Appendix 'B' shall apply to the English Closed Championships.

#### ALTERATION OF RULES

- 68 (a) These Rules and the Laws of the Game, as approved by the Association, may be changed (whether by addition, alteration or deletion) only by decision of an Annual General Meeting or of a Special General Meeting convened for the purpose.
- (b) Proposals for such changes to be considered by the next Annual General Meeting shall be submitted in writing to reach the General Secretary not later than the last day in February. All proposals so received shall be circulated to all County Associations and Local Leagues during March and amendments or alternative proposals dealing with the same substance shall be accepted for consideration by the Annual General Meeting if submitted in writing and received by the General Secretary not later than the last day in April.
- (c) Proposals for such changes to be considered by a Special General Meeting shall be submitted to the General Secretary in writing together with the demand for that Special General Meeting.
- (d) Unless resolved otherwise by the meeting, any alteration to a Rule dealing with Affiliation Fees or other revenue, or with the rebate paid to County Associations shall take effect on the first day of the season next but one after that in which was held the meeting at which it was passed.
- (e) Except as provided by Rule 68(d), any alteration to a Rule shall take effect on the first day of the season following that in which was held the meeting at which it was passed, unless resolved otherwise by such meeting.

#### MATTERS NOT COVERED BY RULES

- 69 In the event of any question or matter arising which is not provided for in the Rules, such question or matter shall be dealt with by the National Council whose decision shall be final.
- 70 (a) Any communication to be sent by the Association to any person or organisation shall be properly sent if addressed to such person or to the General Secretary of such organisation at his last known address.
- (b) A County Association, Local League or club shall on demand supply to the General Secretary or other Officer of the Association the last known address of any Member who is a member of such County Association, Local League or club.

#### AMENDMENTS TO REGULATIONS (referred to above)

**Amendments to Appendix 'A'**  
Amend Regulation 1(d) by substituting £100 for £5 in two places.

**Amendments to Appendix 'D'**

Delete Regulations 1, 2 and 3 and insert:

- "1 (a) No Member of the E.T.T.A. may play, participate in exhibitions or coach outside England unless he has obtained prior permission from the National Council, except as provided in Regulation 1(b).



- (b) A Member may play within the areas under the jurisdiction of the Guernsey Table Tennis Association, the Irish Table Tennis Association, the Jersey Table Tennis Association, the Scottish Table Tennis Association and the Table Tennis Association of Wales without obtaining permission under Regulation 1(a) unless he is a member of the 'E.T.T.A. International Squad'.

2 A Member may apply for and the National Council may grant such permission limited to one event or activity, or covering a number of events or activities or a specified period of time.

3 A member may receive expenses or other remuneration in connection with playing, participating in exhibitions or coaching outside England only if permission, specific to each occasion, shall have been previously requested and received in writing from the E.T.T.A."

#### Amendments to Appendix 'E'

Insert new Regulation as follows:

3A At all times a quorum of three members shall be present.

Insert new Regulation as follows:

3B The Chairman of the Disciplinary Committee shall have the power to impose suspension covering the period from the alleged breach or misconduct until the procedure under this Appendix shall have been carried out.

Delete Regulation 10 and insert as follows:

10 On the completion of the evidence the Hearing shall be closed and the Committee shall give its decision.

11 The decision shall subsequently be communicated in writing by the General Secretary of the Association to the Member or organisation charged and any other Member or organisation concerned, and such decision shall be deemed to be a decision of the Association and binding on all Members and affiliated bodies.

#### REGULATIONS IN FULL (referred to above)

##### Appendix 'F'

- 1 (a) The Competitions shall be open to teams representing Local Leagues. All entries together with the appropriate entry fees must be received at the E.T.T.A. office not later than 15th September each season.
- (b) The entry fee shall be 75p per team for Wilmott Cup and Rose Bowl and 50p per team for Carter Cup and Bromfield Trophy.
- (c) For the purpose of the Regulations for Carter Cup and Bromfield Trophy, University Clubs shall be considered to be Local Leagues.

- 2 (a) In each tie a League shall be represented by three players, (in the Wilmott Cup, Men, in the Rose Bowl, Women, in the Carter Cup, Junior boys, in the Bromfield Trophy, Junior girls) each a member of that League, taking part in the League competition.

NOTE: "Junior" means under 17 years of age on the preceding 30th June.

(b) No player may represent more than one League in the same competition in any one season.

(c) In the Wilmott Cup and Rose Bowl each player must have played in at least four matches in the League competition of the League represented, during the current and/or immediately preceding seasons.

3 In each round teams shall play each other in a tie of nine matches, each match being the best of three games. The tie may be ended by mutual agreement of the captains and with the permission of the Referee, when one team has won five matches.

4 Before each tie the two Captains shall decide by lot the right of being A, B, C, or X, Y, Z and each Captain shall then name his team to the Referee allotting a letter to each of his players. The order of play shall then be as defined in Rule 5 and may be altered only by mutual agreement of the Captains and consent of the Referee.

5 The order of play shall be A v X, B v Y, C v Z, B v X, A v Z, C v Y, B v Z, C v X, A v Y. The interval, if any, should be taken after the fifth match.

6 The entrants shall be divided by the Committee into two areas, which shall be further divided into groups, and sub-divided into zones, no zone containing more than eight entrants. The competitions shall be played on the knock-out system to determine successive zone winners, group winners and area winners, the area winners being the finalists of the competitions.

7 The draw for each zone, group and area, shall be made by the Committee and the result of each round shall be sent to all surviving entrants.

8 Except as provided in Regulation 12, the League drawn first in each tie except the final shall play at home unless both Leagues agree to reverse the fixture or unless a combination is drawn that has occurred within the previous three years in the same competition, when the League playing away on the previous occasion may claim the right to play at home. The League invoking this regulation shall write to the Hon. Secretary of the Committee and visiting League not later than two weeks before the date fixed for the round confirming its acceptance of the responsibility for staging the tie.

9 The closing dates for all rounds shall be decided by the Committee at the beginning of each season, and notified to all participating



leagues. The Committee shall have power to grant an extension of the date for a tie in any round provided application is made to the Hon. Secretary of the Committee by both Leagues before the closing date for that round. Extensions will be granted only if road and rail conditions preclude travelling and permission must be obtained from the Secretary of the Committee.

- 10 The home League shall offer the visiting League the choice of three dates giving not less than one week's notice. At least one of these dates shall be a Saturday and at least one shall be a mid-week date. Three consecutive dates must not be offered. The visiting League must accept one of these dates. Failure to reach agreement must be reported immediately to the Hon. Secretary of the Committee.
- 11 Except as provided in Regulation 12, in all rounds except the final, each League shall be responsible for all expenses of its own team. The home League shall be responsible for the cost of staging the match and for providing refreshments for the visiting team.
- 12 If not less than three-quarters of the entrants in a zone agree, all the matches in that group may be played on one day at one venue, the expenses and receipts being shared equally among all the entrants agreeing to take part in the group play-off.
- 13 The final of each competition shall be played on a date and at a venue selected by the Committee. The E.T.T.A. shall be responsible for the cost of staging the final and for the expenses incurred by the participating teams (four persons in each team) up to an amount not exceeding the combined cost of hotel accommodation and breakfast plus second class rail fare or, when used, 2p per mile for one car—whichever is the cheaper. Any profit made shall be divided 10 per cent to each of the participating League, 10 per cent to the League or affiliated body organising the staging of the tie, and the remainder to the E.T.T.A.
- 14 Ties must begin within 30 minutes of the previously appointed time. Any player not present when called upon by the Referee to play shall forfeit the match for which he is called. Any team playing with less than three players shall be liable to disciplinary action by the Committee.
- 15 It is the responsibility of the winning League to return the official score card. The score card, signed by a representative of each team, must be posted or conveyed so that it is received by the Hon. Secretary of the Committee within 3 days of the final date of each round. Failure to do so shall render the League responsible liable to disciplinary action by the Committee.
- 16 A Referee for each tie or zone play-off shall be appointed by the person or body responsible for staging the tie or zone play-off.
- 17 The playing conditions for each tie shall be as defined in the current E.T.T.A. regulations for Open Tournaments, and the ball shall be any ball currently approved by the E.T.T.A.

18 The competitions shall be managed by a sub-committee, referred to in these regulations as the Committee, who shall be appointed each year by the National Council. The Committee's decision shall be final on all matters arising from these regulations.

19 The regulations of the competitions may only be altered at the beginning of the season by the National Council.

20 The winners of each competition shall be the holders, until the penultimate round of the competition in the following season, of the following trophies:

MEN: the Cup presented by the late A. J. Wilmott;  
WOMEN: the Bowl presented by the late J. M. Rose;

JUNIOR BOYS: the J. Carter Cup;  
JUNIOR GIRLS: the L. M. Bromfield Trophy.

NOTE: The original Wilmott Cup was lost in the bombing of the E.T.T.A. Office in 1940 and the Cup now used is a substitute.

#### Appendix 'G'

- 1 The competitions will be open to teams representing clubs that are acknowledged champions of their own League. Each club must be registered to a League affiliated to the E.T.T.A.
- 2 The clubs shall be represented in each tie by three players who have been bona-fide members of their clubs for at least six months and have played for their club on at least four occasions in the local League competition. The occasions must have taken place during the present and/or the immediately preceding season. No player may represent more than one club in one season without the permission of the Committee.
- 3 Entry Forms will be distributed only to League Secretaries. Each League wishing to enter a Club into the competitions shall ensure that the entry fee of £1 per club team, together with the properly completed Entry Form is received by the Committee Secretary by the second Sunday in October.
- 4 In each round teams shall play each other in a tie of nine matches, each match being the best of three games. The tie may be ended by mutual agreement of the Captains and with the permission of the Referee when one team has won five matches.
- 5 Before each tie the two Captains shall decide by lot the right of being A, B, C, or X, Y, Z and each Captain shall then name his team to the Referee allotting a letter to each of his players. The order of play shall then be as defined in Rule 6 and may be altered only by mutual agreement of the Captains and consent of the Referee.
- 6 The order of play shall be A v X, B v Y, C v Z, B v X, A v Z, C v Y, B v Z, C v X, A v Y. The interval, if any, should be taken after the fifth match.



7 At the discretion of the Committee the tournament may be held continuously at one venue, in which case the draw sheets prepared by the Committee will be sent to the Secretary responsible for each club at least one month before the date of the Tournament.  
NOTE: When this Regulation is invoked, Regulations 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16 will not apply.

8 The entrants shall be divided by the Committee into two areas, which shall be further divided into groups. The competitions shall be played on the knock-out principle to determine successively group and area winners; the area winners being the finalists for the competitions.

9 The draw for each area and group shall be made by the Committee and the result of each round shall be sent to all surviving entrants.

10 Except as provided in Regulation 12, the club drawn first in each tie shall play at home unless both clubs agree to reverse the fixture or unless a combination is drawn that has occurred within the previous three years in the same competition, when the club playing away on the previous occasion may claim the right to play at home. The club invoking this regulation shall write to the Hon. Secretary of the Committee and the visiting club not later than two weeks before the date fixed for the round confirming its acceptance of the responsibility for staging the tie.

11 The closing dates for all rounds including the finals, shall be decided by the Committee at the beginning of each season and notified to all participating clubs. The Committee shall have power to grant an extension of the date for a tie in any round provided application is made to the Hon. Secretary of the Committee by both clubs before the closing date for that round. Extensions will be granted only if road and rail conditions preclude travelling and permission must be obtained from the Secretary of the Committee.

12 The home club shall offer the visiting club the choice of three dates giving not less than one week's notice. At least one of these dates shall be a Saturday and at least one shall be a mid-week date. Three consecutive dates must not be offered. The visiting club must accept one of these dates. Failure to reach agreement must be reported immediately to the Hon. Secretary of the Committee.

13 Each club shall be responsible for all expenses of its own team. The home club shall be responsible for the cost of staging the match and for providing refreshments for the visiting club.

14 If not less than three-quarters of the entrants in a group agree, all the matches in that group may be played on one day at one venue, the expenses and receipts being shared equally among all the entrants agreeing to take part in the group play-off.

15 Ties must begin within 30 minutes of the previously appointed time. Any player not present when called upon by the Referee to play shall forfeit the match for which he is called. Any club playing with less than three players shall be liable to disciplinary action by the Committee.

16 It is the responsibility of the winning club to return the official score card. The score card, signed by a representative of each team, must be posted or conveyed so that it is received by the Hon. Secretary of the Committee within three days of the final date of each round. Failure to do so shall render the clubs responsible liable to disciplinary action by the Committee.

17 A Referee for each tie or group play-off shall be appointed by the person or body responsible for staging the tie or group play-off.

18 The playing conditions for each tie shall be as defined in the current E.T.T.A. regulations for Open Tournaments and the ball shall be any ball currently approved by the E.T.T.A.

19 The competitions shall be managed by a sub-committee, referred to in the regulations as the Committee, who shall be appointed each year by the National Council. The Committee's decision shall be final on all matters arising from these regulations.

20 The regulations of the competitions may only be altered at the beginning of the season by the National Council.

21 Should the E.T.T.A. decide to enter the European Club Championships, the club winning the English Men's Club Championship will be invited to enter for the Europa Pokal Trophy and the club winning the English Ladies' Club Championship for the Coup des club Femminines.

22 Should the E.T.T.A. decide to enter the European Fair Towns Competition, the runners-up of both the English Men's and Ladies Club Championships will be invited to compete for the trophies and prizes of the European Fair Towns Club Championships.

23 Where authority to take part in a European Competition is given by the E.T.T.A. all financial and disciplinary matters are the sole responsibility of the E.T.T.A.
