New development structure - Strategy links

Broadly mirror the 4 p's (without performance):

- Participation; develop programmes to increase levels of participation and/or improve the experience on offer for participant
- Places; support the places that people play and the volunteers that enable play/participation, includes facility work, club management tools, club webinars and conferences
- **People**; education/support/development of key personnel (coaches/officials/event volunteers/teachers/activators








New structure cont.

- Aiming to **improve the experience** in clubs and leagues by offering top standard programmes to be delivered for new and existing members.
- Having clearer roles within the places and participation team will enable staff to deliver more focused and impactive support to clubs, leagues and volunteers.
- Focus on providing and developing programmes for members/players/leagues to utilise
- Create **more flexible workforce** to support sport to progress and have greater impact
- Move from geographical segregation, deemphasise location or lack of location support.
