

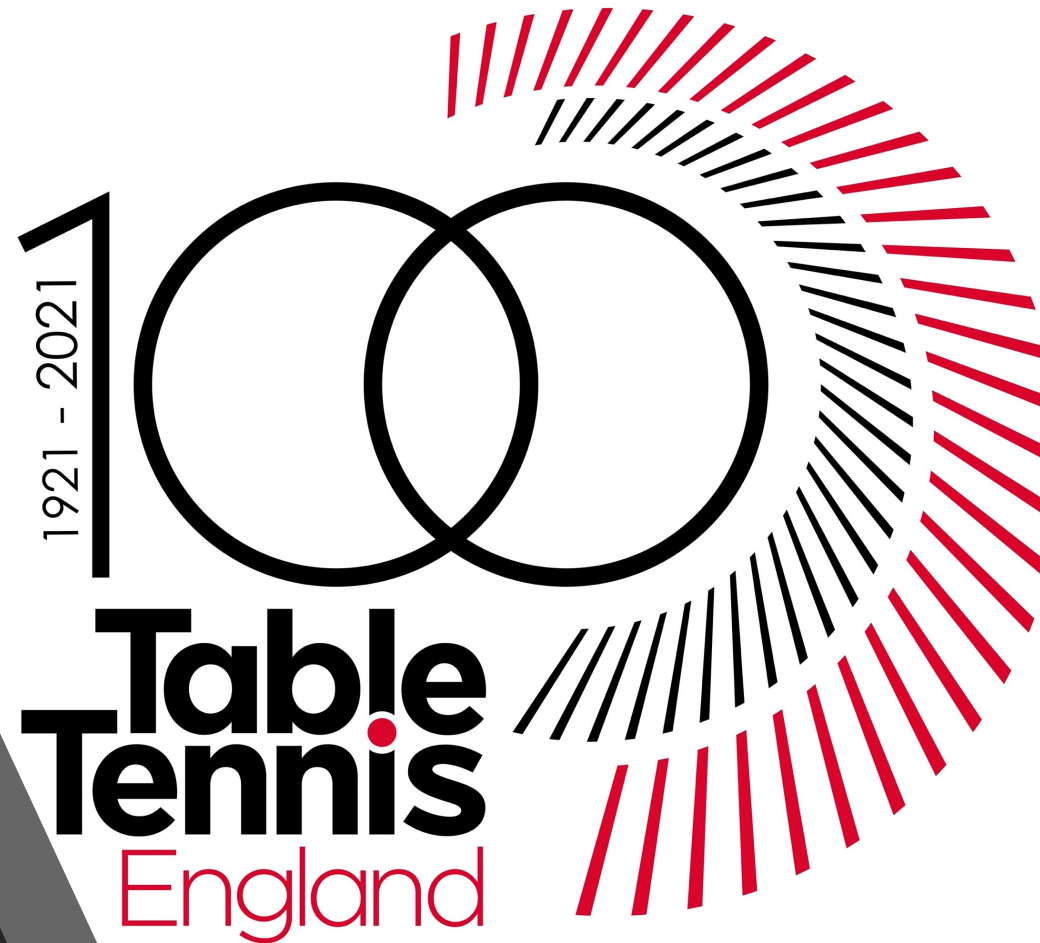

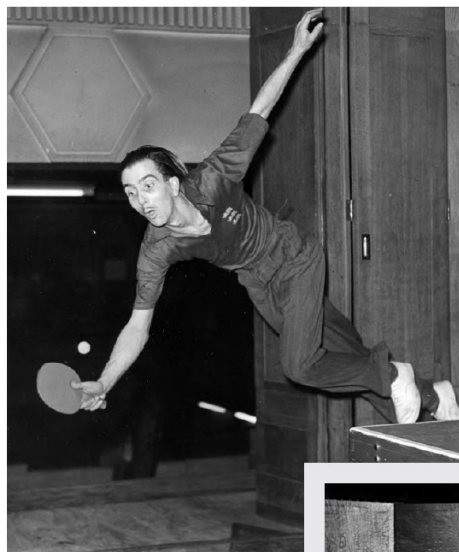

Johnny Leach. Photo Hulton Press from S H Kempster. A leading light in a golden age of English table tennis, Johnny Leach played in 14 World Championships in the post-war years and was Men's Singles champion in 1949 and 1951, as well as being part of the Swaythling Cup winning team in 1953. He also won a number of world silver and bronze medals across singles, doubles and team events, as well as a European Championships team bronze in 1960. A member of the ITTF Hall of Fame, he received an MBE in 1966 and was ETIA President from 1988-2011.

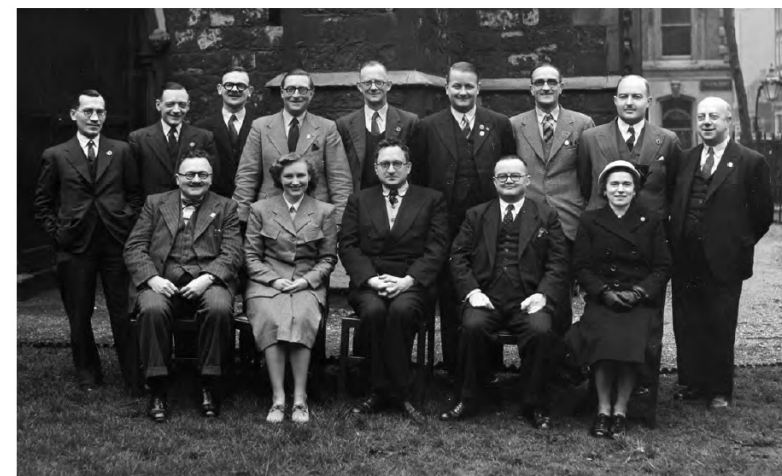

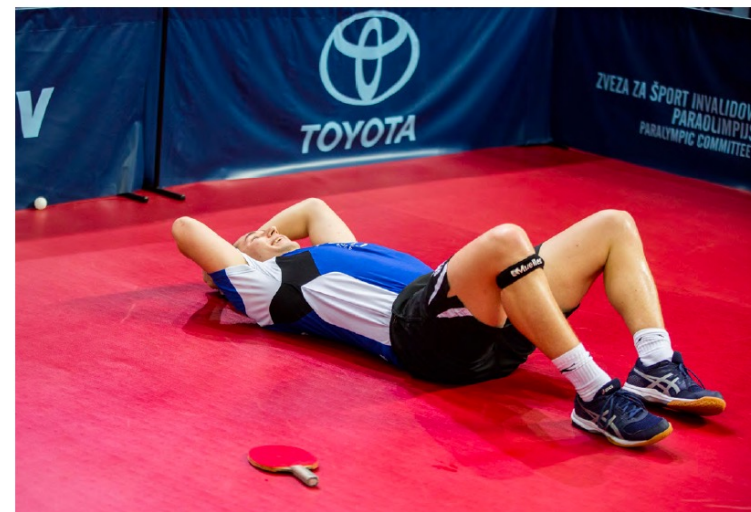
