**TERMS OF REFERENCE****Responsibility**

The Committee will be responsible for investigating Finance within TTE. It will invite submissions and produce a report covering the current situation and provide recommendations for the best way forward.

The Select Committee will be responsible for its own recommendations and actions under its own Terms of Reference and procedures.

**Purpose**

- To focus on and effective budgeting and consideration of expenditure – costs/investment within TTE; including at Club, League and County level.
- To review the current activity by TTE nationally including the effectiveness where money is spent.
- To look at social value and impact of TTE outside the competitive structure.
- To report on any other issues that are drawn to its attention on Finance.
- To identify grants and possible support for developing Table Tennis in England.

**Proposed Membership**

As discussed in National Council meetings in September and January. Members will put themselves forward and National Council will vote on who should be on the committee.
