

National Council Meeting – 27 September 2025

Written Question from Buckinghamshire

A lot of publicity has been sent out by TTE over the last few years about the success of “Ping Pong Parlours”. However, within Buckinghamshire our experience has not been so positive.

Questions to TTE:

- *Does TTE record numbers of any enquiries, whether online or by phone, about local clubs or leagues from people who have played on “Ping” tables or at a “Ping Pong Parlour”?*
- *Does TTE record how many of those enquirers have subsequently become Compete or Associate members of TTE?*
- *If so, could those figures be shared with National Council please?*
- *Are numbers attending “Ping Pong Parlours” recorded in any way that might contribute to TTEs participation figures and boost potential revenue?*

Questions to National Councillors:

- *Are you aware of any increase in membership of local leagues or clubs due to the presence of a local “Ping Pong Parlour”.*
- *Have any local leagues or clubs within your county been positively impacted in any other way due to the presence of a local “Ping Pong Parlour”.*
- *Do any local league or clubs within your county receive advance notification from TTE about the opening of a “Ping Pong Parlour” or, once it is in operation, any communication about it?*
